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**Recipient must fit this criteria:**

*The recipient of the award must be a SCWBEC Member and adhere to all the following criteria:*

1. She alone, or together with one or more women, must own 51% interest of the business.
2. The business must be operational for a minimum of one year.
3. She is involved with day-to-day operations and plays a major role in policy making for the company.
4. The applicant's business or residence must be located in Suffolk County, New York.
5. The business must be a "for profit" company.
6. The applicant must be an active member of SCWBEC.
7. Applicant has not received this award in the past for the same industry classification.
8. Recipient will be required to give a presentation on the use of the award at a SCWBEC meeting within 3 months of receipt of the award. Recipient is required to describe the use of the award in writing within 6 months of receipt to appear on our website.
